- Nobody's fully sure what this is or how to even describe it







- Web based IDE
- No local software install
- Get metadata, create metadata, build SOQL, run tests
- Kind of a combination of VS Code, VS Code for SF Extensions and sfdx
- Intended to be easy for admins and developers to use
- Can install it in a dev edition, but limited to 20 hours/30 days








No new Workflow rules

- Cannot create new ones
- Dev Orgs are the exception (for managed package developers)
- Use flows instead

Enhanced Domains

- Enabled by default
- Your 'My Domain' is included in URLs, Sites, Experience Cloud and so forth
- You'll notice sandboxes are <u>dev1.sandbox.my.salesforce.com</u>
- Old hostnames are redirected to the mydomain
- New event monitoring 'Hostname Redirect' available to all customers (24 hour retention without Shield)

Sandbox Release Upgrade Visibility


- See which sandboxes are on the preview instances

- Create your own custom compound address field
- Still requires the global State and Country picklists
- Doesn't work with Lead Conversion, Approval Processes or Flows

Dynamic Forms Standard Objects

Now supports Account, Person Account, Contact and Opportunity pages



Declarative Development



Call Flows From Completed Cadence Step

- When a cadence step is completed, a Cadence Autolaunched Flow can be invoked
- Flows included by default: update contact owner to cadence target assignee, update lead status to contacted, update opportunity stage to Qualification

Use Screen Flows as Cadence Step

- Specify a Cadence Step Flow to occur as part of a cadence
- Flows included by default: create a case, create an event, create a task

Set FLS to Permission Sets Instead of Profiles (Demo, Beta)

• When creating a new field, assign FLS to a permission set instead of a profile

Larger Modal (Demo)

• The element edit screen is much bigger

Formula Syntax Check (Demo)

• When editing a formula, you can now check the syntax in the modal, not at save

Filter picklists by Record Type in Screen Flows

• Instead of seeing all picklist values for a record, you can now see just the ones relevant to the record type

Update Related Records (Demo)

- Record triggered flow, Account, When Update occurs
- Add update element
- Update records related
- \$Record > Tasks, Opportunities, Events, etc

Multi-Column Screen Flows (Demo)

- Section component now lets you do multi-columns and multi-widths
- Check your old flows (flowLayout=twoColumn), because that might be ignored

Data Tables (Demo, Beta)

- Display a table from a collection
- Lots of other new input types available like call script, password, display image (sidebar_illustration) and slack selectors

DataWeave in Apex (Developer Preview)

- Mulesoft's DataWeave is now available in Apex
- Convert a csv to an SObject

User Mode Apex (Beta)

- Now getQueryLocator, deleteAsync, deleteImmediate, insertAsync, insertImmediate, updateAsync and updateImmediate can be performed in User Mode
- Unlike System Mode, it will honor FLS

Assert Class

- No need to do system.assertEquals() anymore
- Now it's Assert.areEqual()
- Old ones still work, but they recommend moving over
- New options include areEqual, isTrue, isInstanceOfType, isNull and their logical opposites
- Also includes an uncatchable Assert.fail() method to instantly fail the test
